

PARISH OF GROUVILLE



An Assembly of the Principals and Electors of the Parish was held in the Parish Hall on Tuesday 10th November 2020 at 7.45pm to conduct the following business;

- 1) To receive and if deemed advisable approve the Minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Wednesday 5th August 2020.
- 2) The Parishioners are asked to agree that the Parish of Grouville enter into contracts with the owners of field number G189A in order to provide drainage for the road, La Rue du Moulin de Bas, and further to instruct the Connétable and at least one Procureur to attend the Royal Court in order to register the said contracts.
- 3) The Parishioners are asked to agree that the Parish of Grouville should register in the Royal Court the Parishes ownership of the Public fountain and well that is situated on La Rue a Don, south west of the junction with the Parish road Les Huriaux.

Procureur Rebours presided over an assembly of 10 persons.

Procureur Lamy read the convening notice.

- 1) The Minutes of the Parish Assembly dated the 5th August 2020 were agreed, on a proposition by Drew Livingston and seconded by David Cummins. Procureur Rebours duly signed the minutes.
- 2) The Parishioners are asked to agree that the Parish of Grouville enter into contracts with the owners of field number G189A in order to provide drainage for the road, La Rue du Moulin de Bas, and further to instruct the Connétable and at least one Procureur to attend the Royal Court in order to register the said contracts.
