Electoral Assembly

Pursuant to the Act of the Royal Court dated the 8th day of April, whereby it was ordered that an Election for Centenier be held in the Parish of Grouville until June 2025.

Pursuant to Article 19 of the Public Elections (Jersey) Law 2002, an Assembly of the Electors of the Parish of Grouville was held at the Parish Hall on Thursday 21st April at 7.pm.

In the Chair: Connétable JE Le Maistre presided over an assembly approximately 70 persons.

The Connétable welcomed all Parishioners to the meeting.

After the Connétable had read the Convening Notice, the Connétable invited Nominations to fill the position of Centenier to complete a 3 year term until June 2025.

Albert John Lamy (AJL) proposed Mr Nicholas John Andrews. He explained that Nick Andrews had been in the Grouville Honorary Police since 2006 and prior to that had served in the St Clement Honorary Police. Mr Lamy noted that Mr Andrews always carried out his duties with due care and diligence. Mr Lamy then read out the nomination paper. The names on the nomination paper were checked and confirmed to be registered on the electoral roll.

Mr Bernard Rebours seconded Mr Andrews noting that he had been a part of the recruitment campaign that had seen the number of officers within the Grouville Honorary Police rise significantly.

The Connétable waited the required 10 minutes and then asked if there were any other nominations. As there were no other nominations the Connétable declared Centenier Nick Andrews duly elected. The Connétable congratulated Mr Andrews and thanked him for his service to the Parish and warned him to appear before the Royal Court to take his oath at 10am on the 10th June.
