<b><u>Minutes of the Parish Assembly</u></b> <b><u>Held in Grouville Parish Hall on</u></b> <b><u>Monday, 18, July 2022 at 19.00</u></b>	
<b>PRESENT</b>	Connétable Mark Labey – Chairman  Daryn Cleworth – Parish Secretary and Minutes
<b>1. Open Meeting</b>	Connétable Mark Labey opened the meeting and welcomed everyone in attendance.  The Connétable explained that item 3 of the Convening Notice had been withdrawn but would be rescheduled for a later Assembly.
<b>2. Apologies</b>	Apologies were received from the following:  Mr John Le Maistre – out of island Mr Chris Osgood Mrs Caroline Osgood Rev Helen Gunton Deputy Carolyn Labey
<b>3. Approval of Minutes</b>	The minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Monday, 13 June 2022 were proposed by Mrs Tracy Laurent, seconded by Mr John O'Brien, and duly approved unanimously.
<b>4. Elect a Roads Inspector for Vingtaine des Marais</b>	A nomination for Roads Inspector for the Vingtaine des Marais was received from Mr William Payn. He was proposed by Mr Peter Le Maistre, who said it gave him great pleasure that Mr Payn had stepped up in the family tradition by putting his name forward. Mr Payn had lived in the Parish all his life, was approachable and practical and would make an ideal Roads Inspector.  Mr Payn's nomination was seconded by Mr David Cummins, who added Mr Payn was a good, young addition to the team and could drive a tractor, a valuable attribute that he could use to tow obstructing trees out of the road. He continued that it was good to see young people coming through and getting on board Parish's honorary system.  Having received no further nominations, Connétable Labey duly declared Mr Payn elected as Roads Inspector for the Vingtaine des Marais and congratulated him on his election.
<b>5. Elect a Roads Inspector for Vingtaine de la Rue</b>	A nomination for Roads Inspector for the Vingtaine de la Rue was received from Mr Philip Le Maistre, who was proposed by Mr Andrew Labey. Mr Labey advised the meeting that Mr Le Maistre had plenty of common sense, but felt the most important attribute that he

	<p>brought was local knowledge, having spent most of his life in and around La Rue.</p> <p>He was seconded by Mr John Lamy, who added that it had been some 3 weeks since the Parish had a Le Maistre in the municipality.</p> <p>Having received no further nominations, Connétable Labey duly declared Mr Le Maistre elected as Roads Inspector for the Vingtaine de la Rue and congratulated him on his election.</p> <p>Connétable warned both newly elected Roads Inspectors to appear in the Royal Court on Friday, 22 July 2022 at 10:00 for the swearing in.</p>
