<u>Minutes of the Nomination Meeting</u> <u>Held in Grouville Parish Hall on</u> <u>Wednesday, 17, May 2023 at 19:00</u>

Open Meeting	<p>Connétable Labey opened the meeting and welcomed everyone in attendance and asked the parish Secretary to read the Convening Notice.</p> <p>The fire exits were pointed out and the Connétable reminded everyone that this evening's Nomination Meeting will then be followed by a Parish Assembly, which cannot start until 19:20.</p> <p>The Connétable went on to advise those present that both the nomination meetings and Parish Assembly to follow will be recorded for the sake of verifying the minutes, should the need arise. Once they have been approved the recordings are deleted permanently.</p>

Introduction	<p>The Connétable advised the same format will be followed for all of the nominations this evening, with proposers speaking for up to 3 minutes before reading out the nomination forms. The reading of the form is not included in the 3 minute permitted time limit.</p> <p>Candidates are not permitted to speak, other than to thank their proposers, seconders and supporters if they so wish.</p> <p>If there is only one candidate for the role, then they will be duly elected this evening and warned for swearing in at the Royal Court in due course. If</p>

	more than one candidate, then a poll will be held at the Parish Hall on Wednesday, 21 June 2023.										
1. To elect a Centenier to complete a term of office expiring 18 March 2024.	<p>The Connétable asked for nominations for the role of Centenier to complete a term ending 18 March 2024.</p> <p>There were no nominations so the Connétable informed the meeting that he will notify the Royal Court and call for a further Nomination Meeting for this post in due course.</p>										
<p>2. To elect a Centenier to complete a term of office expiring 9 September 2024.</p> <p>3. To elect a Centenier to complete a term of office expiring 23 June 2025.</p>	<p>The Connétable asked for nominations for the role of Centenier to complete a term of office expiring 9 Sept 2024. Anne Elizabeth Viney proposed Paul Alan Robinson.</p> <p>Mrs Viney informed the meeting that Mr Robinson will be known to many in the Parish having only recently completed a term of office. She advised that he was born in Durham on 19 June 1956. He ran a children's home for Kent County Council. He studied at Canterbury College and qualified in business studies and worked mainly in catering and food supplies, before later running one of the largest Meals on Wheels food supplies in Kent.</p> <p>He met his wife, whose profession as a lawyer brought them to Jersey. He later joined the Grouville Honorary Police as a CO, before becoming Centenier. He has a total of 10 years' service, with some breaks, during which time he worked for Le Marais Marine and qualified as a power boat instructor. Having now retired, he has provided assurances that he now has the time to apply himself to the role of Centenier. Drew Livingston was one of those officers and had graduated from Cambridge University and has worked in the finance industry for many years, the past 3 ½ years of which he has been employed as a supervisor at the JFSC.
