over 50 years and a CO for 3 years. Mrs Lange-Smith had worked with Ms Palmer on the same Honoroary Police Team and said she was a good team player and always felt Ms Palmer had her back. Ms Palmer's nomination was seconded by Anne Elizabeth Viney.

The Connétable asked for any other nominations and, as there were no further candidates, declared Samantha Jayne Palmer as duly elected and warned her to attend the Royal Court for swearing in at 09:45 on Friday, 19 May 2023.

3. To elect a
Vingtenier for the

The Connétable asked for nominations for the role of Vingtenier for the Vingtaine de Longueville.

Wendy Lange-Smith proposed Ewa Alicja Gracz for the role and informed the meeting that Mrs Gracz was sworn in as CO 3 years prior at the same time as herself, here in the Parish Hall, over Teams due to the pandemic. She was a good Constable's Officer during that time and has been resident in Jersey for 20 years, and Grouville for 5 of those. Mrs Lange-Smith added that she had watched Mrs Gracz grow in confidence. She is a qualified bookkeeper and has showed a strong ability to juggle multiple tasks.

Mrs Gracz's nomination was seconded by Harry Meacham.

As there were no further nominations, the Connétable declared Ewa Alicja Gracz as duly elected and warned her to attend the Royal Court for swearing in at 09:45 on Friday, 19 May 2023.

4. In conformity with Article 5 of the Loi (1914) sur la Voirie, to elect one candidate to act as a Roads Inspector to complete a term of office expiring 31 December 2023.

Bernard Rebours proposed Helier John Falle and advised that he had been in the Parish for some time and has 2 children being educated at Grouville School. He also had a family relative that served as Procureur du Bien Public of the Parish and one of the founder members of Port Bail. Mr Falle is a director of Falles Motor Works and Falles Property Management. He has degree in business property management, having studied in the Ukraine.

Mr Falle's nomination was seconded by Albert John Lamy.
