<b><u>Minutes of the Parish Assembly</u></b> <b><u>Held at Grouville Parish Hall on</u></b> <b><u>Thursday, 29 August 2024 at 19:00</u></b>	
<b>PRESENT</b>	Connétable Mark Labey – Chairman  Patricia da Silva – Parish Secretary and Minutes
<b>Open Meeting</b>	The Connétable opened the meeting by welcoming everyone in attendance and pointed out the fire exits at the Parish Hall. The Connétable informed that the meeting will be recorded for the purpose of accurate minute taking.  The Connétable invited the Parish Secretary to read out the Convening Notice.
<b>Apologies</b>	Apologies were received from the following:  Robert Hurley and Drew Livingston.
<b>1. To receive and if deemed advisable approve the minutes of the Parish Assembly held on 30 July 2024.</b>	The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday, 30 July 2024 were proposed by Leslie Norman and seconded by Tracy Laurent. The Assembly voted and the minutes were approved unanimously.
<b>2. To recommend to the Licensing Assembly applications for licences for the year 2024 in virtue of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974.</b>	Daniel Young spoke on behalf of Smajda and Co Ltd regarding the licence application for the premises Veranda, for a 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> category licence. The premises will be a coffee shop, bakery, bistro and will sell specific wines and beers to be taken away and had off the premises.  The Connétable invited questions from the floor and advised that anyone who speaks will be entitled to address the Licensing Assembly on Thursday, 26 September 2024.  The Assembly had no questions or comments.  The Connétable asked for a proposer and seconder for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 6 <sup>th</sup> category licence application.  The application was proposed by Jason Masterman and seconded by Janice Evans. The Assembly voted and the application was approved unanimously.
