2. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 04 December 2024 were proposed by DBC and seconded by SP and duly adopted.
3. Matters Arising	
3.1. Road Signs	ML advised that the following road signs have been ordered: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- La Chevre Rue x3- Le Cotil Vautier x2- Les Monts x2- La Rue des Moulins x2- La Rue des Teurs Champ x2 The Roads Committee (RC) agreed to order further signs for: <ul style="list-style-type: none">- La Rue Laurens- La Rue du Douettin- Le Passage de L’Hopital- Le Passage Danby ACTION POINT: ML to order the above signs.
4. Planning Applications	The RC inspected the following applications: P/2024/1401 P/2024/1389 P/2024/1366 P/2024/1358 P/2024/1305 No concerns were reported, however, ML requested that a comment is made for application P/2024/1366 to advise that vehicles should not park on the road. ACTION POINT: LS to contact the Planning Department regarding application P/2024/1366.

<p>5. Cycle Paths</p>	<p>The RC discussed the proposed cycle route plans submitted by the Minister for Infrastructure and expressed their concerns regarding the route from Le Boulivot de Bas to Rue de la Retraite, as it is a dangerous narrow road.</p> <p>ACTION POINT: ML to contact the Department for Infrastructure.</p> <p>ML requested it was minuted that the small area of pavement at the end of the cycle route, on Grouville Common is used by cyclists when it shouldn't be. ML said that this has been raised with the Department for Infrastructure who are responsible for that area.</p>
<p>6. Visite du Branchage 2025</p>	<p>The RC agreed to hold the Visites du Branchage on the following dates:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Friday, 04 July at 16:00 - Friday, 19 September at 16:00
<p>7. La Rue du Val Poucin Drainage</p>	<p>EG requested that a site visit is arranged with the Parish of St Saviour to further discuss the drainage at La Rue du Val Poucin.</p> <p>ACTION POINT: PDS to contact the Parish of St Saviour.</p>
<p>6. AOB</p>	
<p>6.1. Le Catillon</p>	<p>DBC expressed his concern regarding the evergreen oaks along Le Catillon which have split and may come down onto the road.</p> <p>ACTION POINT: ML to contact the landowner.</p>
<p>6.2. Birds</p>	<p>HG requested an update regarding the feral birds around the Parish. ML advised that Environmental Health have been contacted. After further discussion, the RC agreed to place no feeding bird signs in the affected areas.</p> <p>ACTION POINT: ML to contact Environmental Health again, Master Farms and the National Trust.</p>
<p>6.3. Fauvic Crossroads</p>	<p>EG mentioned that it would be beneficial to meet with HD Planning and Design Ltd to discuss improving road safety at Fauvic Crossroads.</p> <p>ACTION POINT: PDS to arrange a site visit with HD Planning and Design Ltd and the RC.</p>
<p>6.4. La Rue du Moulin de Bas</p>	<p>DBC advised that a tree on La Rue du Moulin de Bas has fallen into the field and has damaged the edge of the road. DBC said he will investigate how the road is supported once the tree has been cleared.</p> <p>ML said there is an issue with road subsidence at the top of La Rue du Moulin de Bas and he will be contacting engineers to provide quotes to repair the road.</p>
