Open Meeting	<p>The Connétable opened the meeting by welcoming everyone in attendance. To elect a Centenier to complete a term of office expiring June 2028	<p>The Connétable reminded those in attendance that if there is more than one candidate this evening, then an election will be held on Wednesday, 11 June 2025.
