<b><u>Minutes of the Parish Assembly</u></b> <b><u>Held at Grouville Parish Hall on</u></b> <b><u>Tuesday, 20 May 2025 at 19:00</u></b>

<b>1. The Assembly had no questions or comments.  The Connétable asked for a proposer and seconder for the 3 <sup>rd</sup> category licence application.  The application was proposed by Robert Hurley and seconded by Tracy Laurent. The Assembly voted and the application was approved by the majority.
