### **Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting** **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Wednesday, 21 May 2025 at 09:45**

<b>2. Stolpersteine Installation Request</b>	<p>The WWII Fortifications Curator put forward a request to install a stolperstein outside La Boulivot de Bas for Emile John Paisnel, who was one of the Jersey 21 who were deported for acts of disobedience and defiance.</p> <p>The Roads Committee (RC) expressed their concerns that the initials match those of the Beast of Jersey, who lived at La Boulivot de Bas. ML said he would only support the installation of the stolperstein providing it is installed in a different location. ML said he would consider laying the stone outside the Parish Hall.</p>

<b>3. Road Traffic Order Amendments</b>	<p>Operations and Transport and the RC discussed the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- No change to the parking restriction on Le Mont de Gouray, however ML said he will consult with the Honorary Police and businesses at Gorey Village.</li><li>- ML to liaise with the Honorary Police regarding potential 3-hour limit signage at Le Vier Mont.</li><li>- No additional disabled parking bays required in Gorey Village.</li><li>- The RC confirmed that the Parish were not made aware that Evie parking bays were going to be placed in Gorey Village. Operations and Transport said they would investigate the matter as the RC advised this has created issues for shoppers in the area.</li><li>- A 1-hour limit to be placed at the layby on La Rue a Don adjacent to La Croix Cemetery.</li><li>- Operations and Transport to look at the road edge markings on La Grande Route des Sablons to improve public safety by the bus stop near the junction of La Marais a La Cocque.</li></ul>

<b>4. Approval of Minutes</b>	The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday, 15 April 2025 were proposed by SP and seconded by EG and duly adopted.
<b>5. Matters Arising</b>	
<b>5.1. Painted Pavements</b>	ML confirmed he will hand deliver notices to residents at La Rue de la Haye du Puits, to notify the residents of the painted pavement work due to be undertaken in the area.
<b>6. Planning Applications</b>	<p>The RC inspected the following applications:</p> <p><b>P/2025/0336</b>  <b>S/2025/0326</b>  <b>S/2025/0279</b>  <b>P/2025/0274</b></p> <p>No concerns were reported.</p>
<b>7. Speed Limits</b>	ML notified the RC that Infrastructure and Environment will be reviewing speed limits with the Parish hopefully later this year.
<b>8. P/2025/0264</b>	<p>EG referred to planning application P/2025/0264 and expressed his concerns that the drainage outlet is located near a Parish road, which may result in water being deposited onto the road, potentially leading to water accumulation and impacting road conditions.</p> <p><b>ACTION POINT: LS to contact Planning and Building Control.</b></p>
<b>9. La Rue du Val Poucin</b>	<p>The RC confirmed, following a site visit, that the issues arising with the drain at La Rue du Val Poucin is not the responsibility of the Parish.</p> <p><b>ACTION POINT: LS to arrange a site visit with the Parish of St Saviour.</b></p>
<b>10. Budget</b>	<p>The RC advised that the following projects and roads that will require maintenance should be budgeted for in the roads reserve with the approval of the Parish Assembly:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Painted Pavements</li> <li>- La Charriere au Long</li> <li>- La Chevre Rue (Daisy Hill)</li> <li>- La Ruelle Mathurin</li> <li>- La Catillon/La Rue du Moulin de Bas</li> <li>- La Rue des Vaux</li> </ul>
