Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Wednesday, 18 June 2025 at 10:00**

1. Apologies	None.
2. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 21 May 2025 were proposed by DBC and seconded by SP and duly adopted.
3. Matters Arising	
3.1. P/2025/0264	EG requested that it was minuted that planning application P/2025/0264 has been approved, despite the Roads Committee (RC) raising their concerns regarding the drainage outlet located near a Parish road, which may result in water being deposited onto the road and impacting the road.
3.2. Stolpersteine Installation Request	ML referred to item two of the minutes of 21 May 2025 and advised that no alternative location has been found to install the stolpersteine and therefore, ML has offered to install the stone outside the Parish Hall. EG expressed that ML must have approval from parishioners first before making a final decision.
4. Planning Applications	The RC inspected the following applications: RP/2025/0419 P/2025/0423 P/2025/0420 RC/2025/0406 No concerns were reported.
5. La Rue Jutize	ML advised of complaints regarding the overflow of drains during heavy downpours on La Rue Jutize and affecting certain properties. ML explained that the Voisinage Law specifies that properties must have provision to accept water from properties that are located further up from them.
6. La Ruelle Mathurin	The RC approved works to take place on La Ruelle Mathurin to retarmac the road, however the RC advised they would like a minimum of two weeks' notice before any work commences.
7. AOB	
7.1. Painted Pavements	The RC confirmed they are satisfied with the outcome of the painted pavements, which has successfully fulfilled its intended purpose. The RC acknowledged that there has been some negative feedback, however a significant number of positive responses have been received. EG requested that it was minuted that some issues might have been resolved more efficiently had ML had prior discussions with the RC before responding to certain external communications. ML acknowledged EG's comment.

7.2. La Rue des Alleurs	The RC agreed that pollarding of the two trees on the Parish Hall wall is required in preparation for the wall repair.
