Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Monday, 23 June 2025 at 10:00**

1. Apologies	<p>Rev. Helen Gunton and Liz Sheehan.</p>
2. Painted Pavements	<p>ML apologised to RA about any stressed caused to the residents at Haie du Puits on La Rue de la Haye du Puits regarding the small section of pavement painted outside their estate near the road, which does not belong to the Parish of Grouville.</p> <p>DBC commented that the Government of Jersey have confirmed that the material used is not toxic and also highlighted that the colour red is used in the UK.</p> <p>RA expressed that the residents at Haie du Puits have requested the section of painted pavement reinstated to how it was.</p> <p>DBC said solvents cannot be used and through verbal advice obtained and DBC's own experience, the section of painted pavement cannot be reinstated to exactly how it was.</p> <p>DBC mentioned that the RC will consider painting the same pavement on the actual road on La Rue de la Haye du Puits to which RA disagreed with.</p> <p>After further discussion, it was agreed between the Roads Committee (RC) and RA to remove the painted pavement outside the estate with disc cutters and replace it with black tarmac.</p> <p>ML warned that the colour of the tarmac will be obvious as it will be fresh. RA understood and acknowledged it will wear down over time.</p> <p>RA confirmed that the residents will be happy to have the pavement outside the estate reinstatement during the school holidays.</p> <p>EG advised that the contractors who reinstate the area must make residents aware prior to the work commencing.</p>
