### **Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting** **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Friday, 19 September 2025 at 15:00**

<b>Present</b>	Mark Labey – Connétable (ML) Eric Gavey (EG) Stanley Payn (SP) David Cummins (DBC)  Patricia da Silva – Parish Secretary and Minutes (PDS)
<b>1. Apologies</b>	Rev. Helen Gunton and Liz Sheehan.
<b>2. Approval of Minutes</b>	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 06 August 2025 were proposed by EG and seconded by SP and duly adopted.
<b>3. Matters Arising</b>	
<b>3.1. Painted Pavements</b>	EG commented that the Roads Committee (RC) continue to receive positive verbal feedback regarding the painted red pavements.  DBC requested that it was minuted that Jersey Airport Departure Lounge have introduced a marked red pavement for pedestrians.
<b>4. Planning Applications</b>	The RC inspected the following applications:  <b>RP/2025/0842</b> <b>P/2025/0783</b>  The RC expressed concerns regarding parking for application RP/2025/0842 and agreed to arrange a site visit.  No further concerns were reported.
<b>5. La Rue de la Sente Maillard</b>	ML raised a concern reported regarding the condition of La Rue de la Sente Maillard. The RC agreed to arrange a site visit to the road.
<b>6. Speed Limits</b>	ML reminded the RC of the Parish Assembly taking place on Thursday, 25 September at 19:00 regarding speed limits.  ML referred to the Road Traffic (Speed Limits) (Jersey) Order 2003 and highlighted that La Rue de la Marais à la Cocque is 30mph only from La Grande Route des Sablons to a point 36 yards west of La Grande Route des Sablons. The rest of the road is 40mph.
<b>7. La Rue du Parcq</b>	ML referred to a matter raised regarding cracks on La Rue du Parcq. It was noted that water ingress and the passage of large, heavy vehicles appear to be causing expedited breakdown of the road. There is particular concern that, if left, this could eventually impact the underlying gas mains.  The RC agreed to arrange a site visit and if there is cause for concern, will contact Island Energy.
<b>8. AOB</b>	
<b>8.1. La Rue du Moulin de Bas</b>	EG mentioned that the trees at La Rue du Moulin de Bas have been cut by Treevolution Tree Surgeons as requested by the RC and D B Cummins Ltd continued the rest of the work and cleared the area.

<b>8.2. La Croix Cemetery Parking</b>	<p>EG stressed that parking on the layby at La Croix Cemetery is becoming increasingly problematic and implementing a parking time limit should be made a priority, as the current situation is making it difficult for people to visit the cemetery.</p> <p><b>ACTION POINT: ML to contact Infrastructure and Environment.</b></p>
<b>8.3. Road Signs</b>	<p>DBC requested that triangle school warning signs are put up on the following roads:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- La Rue de la Haye du Puits</li> <li>- La Rue des Fonds</li> <li>- Rue de la Croix</li> </ul> <p>ML agreed.</p>
<b>8.4. Les Minquiers</b>	<p>SP requested that it was minuted that the following were invited to the official visit and inspection of Les Minquiers on Thursday, 18 September 2025:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- The Connétable</li> <li>- Procureur du Bien Public</li> <li>- Chairmen of the Rates Assessment Committee</li> <li>- Roads Committee member</li> <li>- Parish Secretary</li> <li>- One office staff member</li> </ul> <p>These individuals were included in a party arranged with the Receiver General and in attendance was His Excellency, the Lieutenant Governor of Jersey, Vice Admiral Sir Jerry Kyd KBE.</p> <p>The Union Flag was raised and everybody responded with "God save the King".</p>
