<u>Minutes of the Parish Assembly</u> <u>Held at Grouville Parish Hall on</u> <u>Tuesday, 25 November 2025 at 19:00</u>	
PRESENT	Connétable Mark Labey – Chairman Patricia da Silva – Parish Secretary and Minutes
Open Meeting	<p>The Connétable opened the meeting by welcoming everyone in attendance and pointed out the fire exits at the Parish Hall. The Connétable informed that the meeting will be recorded for the purpose of accurate minute taking and advised that anyone who wishes their name to be omitted from the minutes should inform him accordingly.</p> <p>The Connétable advised that all votes taken this evening will be by a show of hands.</p> <p>The Connétable invited the Parish Secretary to read out the Convening Notice.</p>
Apologies	Apologies were received from the following: Drew Livingston, Helen Gunton and Deputy Carolyn Labey.
1. To receive and if deemed advisable approve the minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Tuesday, 14 October 2025.	The minutes of the meeting held on Tuesday, 14 October 2025 were proposed by Eric Gavey and seconded by Adrian Le Gal. The Assembly voted and the minutes were approved by the majority.
2. To recommend to the Licensing Assembly an application for the grant of a licence for the year 2025 in virtue of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974.	<p>Claudio Abreu spoke on behalf of Chicken Run Jersey Limited regarding the licence application for the premises Old Bank House, for a 4th category licence. Claudio Abreu intends to restore the Old Bank House for the community. The premises will accommodate an all-day dining restaurant, offering breakfast, lunch and dinner, along with an alfresco seating area.</p> <p>Claudio Abreu confirmed the following in answer to questions from the floor:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- The premises will operate seven days a week. Opening hours will be from 08:00 to 01:00, with the kitchen closing and food service ending at 22:00.- Takeaway service will be available.- Onsite parking will be available for 17 vehicles. Nearby parking spaces are also available.- The restaurant can accommodate up to 60 people. <p>The Connétable asked for a proposer and seconder for the 4th category licence application.</p>

	<p>The application was proposed by Paul Murphy and seconded by Danny Cole. The Assembly voted by a show of hands with 10 votes in favour and 0 against.</p> <p>The Connétable congratulated Claudio Abreu for returning the Old Bank House to its former prominence.</p>
