1. Apologies	Rev. Helen Gunton and David Cummins.

2. Parking Proposals	<p>Infrastructure and Environment referred to the Road Traffic (Grouville) (Jersey) Order 2002, article 8 to assist the Roads Committee (RC) with their final decision on the parking restriction on La Rue des Fonds.</p> <p>I&E referred to the RC’s previous proposal of a 30-minute parking disc restriction between 07:00 and 16:00 and suggested a 12 in 24-hour parking restriction instead, as this would have the same effectiveness. The RC disagreed due to nearby winter lets, where occupants often have two vehicles who would potentially take advantage of the 12 in 24 hour by alternating their vehicles.</p> <p>The RC agreed on the following new proposed parking restriction on La Rue des Fonds:</p> <p>1 hour parking disc restriction between 07:00 and 17:30.</p> <p>I&E advised that this restriction will apply to all 1-hour disc zones in the Parish.</p> <p>The RC requested to I&E that yellow lines are placed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • along La Rue des Fonds to the entrance of Clos de L’Eglise; and • on the opposite side of the road, from the junction of La Rue des Fonds up to the top of the garden wall of La Prevalaye.

3. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 14 January 2026 were proposed by SP and seconded by EG and duly adopted.
4. Matters Arising	None.
5. Le Grand Bourg Drainage	The RC discussed a concern reported regarding an obstructed drain at Le Grand Bourg. A drain survey was provided, however the RC requested more

	<p>information on who undertook the survey to allow them to investigate the matter further.</p> <p>EG commented that foliage from an overgrown hedge also appears to be falling into the drain, potentially causing further blockage. ML said he will attempt to contact the landowner.</p>
6. Road Signage	<p>Following an issue raised that a road sign named 'Les Monts' had been incorrectly placed on a road believed to be La Chevre Rue, the RC confirmed that the sign had been placed correctly. They clarified that La Chevre Rue is located further along Les Monts on the 'V' junction of Daisy Hill House.</p>
7. Draft Road and Vehicle Law	<p>The RC nominated David Cummins to attend a meeting for a roads law review discussion.</p>
8. La Rue Maraval	<p>The RC agreed to arrange a site visit to La Rue Maraval following a query received regarding the area where the boundary stones are located.</p>
9. Planning Applications	<p>The RC inspected the following applications, focusing solely on potential impacts on roads:</p> <p>P/2026/10676 P/2026/10663 P/2026/10600 P/2026/10608 P/2026/10592 P/2026/10565 P/2026/10561 P/2026/10554</p> <p>The RC highlighted concerns regarding visual splays and parking availability under application P/2026/10561. The RC agreed to request further information.</p> <p>No further concerns were reported.</p>
