Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Wednesday, 22 April 2026 at 10:00**

1. Apologies	None.
2. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on Monday, 23 March 2026 were proposed by SP and seconded by DBC and duly adopted.
3. La Rue des Alleurs Wall	<p>The Roads Committee (RC) expressed a preference to appoint a contractor who is already familiar with the building’s electrical systems, to undertake the electrical works associated with part of the La Rue des Alleurs wall project, subject to approval. This would enable the work to be carried out with limited disruption and allow business operations to continue as normal at the Parish Hall.</p> <p>ML advised that more than one quote must be requested from contractors.</p> <p>The Procureurs thanked the RC for their time and technical help with the project.</p>
4. Matters Arising	
4.1. La Rue des Alleurs Quarry	ML referred to item 6 of the RC meeting minutes from 23 March 2026 and advised as there may be delays to the wall project on La Rue des Alleurs, he will inform the landowner of the quarry to arrange to remove the top of the bank by the entrance of the quarry as soon as possible.
5. Potholes	Following reports received regarding potholes on Le Boulivot de Bas, the RC agreed to arrange a site visit to the area.
6. Le Grand Bourg Drainage	The RC requested that this item is discussed at the next meeting as they have not yet received the completed drain survey.
7. Road Signs	The RC discussed a concern that was raised regarding the absence of road signs on La Sente des Fonds. ML advised that road signs cannot be placed until permission from landowners has been received.
8. La Rue des Vaux	DBC confirmed that one quote has been received for roadworks on La Rue des Vaux and he is awaiting one more.
9. Planning Applications	The RC inspected the following applications, focusing solely on potential impacts on roads:

10.1. La Rue Mauthrin	Following reports of flooding on La Rue Mauthrin, the RC advised that further investigation will be undertaken on the drains in the area, however the meadow requires cutting back to allow the RC access to the drains. ML said he will contact the landowners.
10.2. Sink Hole	<p>DBC advised that the sink hole on La Rue Hilgrove was urgently repaired. The area has been reinforced to avoid any collapse in the future.</p> <p>The material that was left over was used to repair the potholes on La Rue des Alleurs.</p>
10.3. Don Lauren	DBC advised that the grass surrounding the trees on Don Lauren field at La Rue de La Marais a La Cocque requires cutting back. ML said he will arrange a site visit.
10.4. Vice Dean	The RC congratulated HG on her successful appointment of Vice Dean.
10.5. Speed Limit Review	<p>ML apologised for being unable to attend the drop-in session held at the Parish Hall for the proposed reduced speed limits, arranged by the Government of Jersey.</p> <p>The RC confirmed that the Government of Jersey have been reminded that La Cache des Pres should be reduced to 30mph.</p>
