<u>Minutes of the Parish Assembly</u> <u>Held at Grouville Parish Hall on</u> <u>Wednesday, 20 May 2026 at 19:00</u>

Open Meeting	The Procureur opened the meeting by welcoming everyone in attendance and pointed out the fire exits at the Parish Hall. The Procureur informed that the meeting will be recorded for the purpose of accurate minute taking and advised that anyone who wishes their name to be omitted from the minutes should inform him accordingly. The Procureur advised that all votes taken this evening will be by a show of hands. The Procureur invited the Parish Secretary to read out the Convening Notice.
Apologies	Apologies were received from the following: Collette Labey and Deputy Carolyn Labey, who requested that it was noted that she is attending a Senatorial Hustings in the Parish of St Martin.
1. To receive and if deemed advisable approve the minutes of the Parish Assembly held on Wednesday, 06 May 2026.	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 06 May 2026 were proposed by Mark Labey and seconded by Filippo Rizzuto. The Assembly voted and the minutes were approved by the majority.
2. To recommend to the Licensing Assembly an application for the grant of a licence for the year 2026 in virtue of the Licensing (Jersey) Law 1974.	Keilly Harvey spoke on behalf of Paddock Events regarding the licence application for the premises Flamenco Villa, for a 6th category off-licence. Keilly Harvey advised she is very familiar with conditions of selling alcohol. This extension of the business is to offer grazing platters, with the option of purchasing a bottle of wine. The Procureur invited questions from the floor and advised that anyone who speaks will be entitled to address the Licensing Assembly on Thursday, 18 June 2026. Keilly Harvey confirmed the following in answer to questions from the floor: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Wine is not delivered or stored at Flamenco Villa. Instead, any wine ordered is purchased and collected from Love Wine. All platters and wine ordered will be delivered directly to the consumer and therefore, this will not impact traffic. - Flamenco Villa has obtained a Food Safety Rating Certificate. - Less than half a dozen orders are received for platters.
