Minutes of the Roads Committee Meeting **Held at Grouville Parish Hall on** **Wednesday, 17 June 2026 at 10:00**

1. Apologies	Stanley Payn
2. Approval of Minutes	The minutes of the meeting held on Wednesday, 20 May 2026 were proposed by EG and seconded by DBC and duly adopted.
3. Matters Arising	
3.1. Jersey Rally	ML reiterated DBC's comment in item 5 of the minutes of the meeting held Wednesday, 20 May 2026 and advised minuted meetings will be held with Jersey Rally in future.
3.2. Road Signs	Following comments made from parishioners regarding the lack of road name signs, ML advised that road name signs cannot be placed until permission has been given to the Parish from landowners.
4. Parking Concerns	ML advised he will be seeking advice from Infrastructure and Environment (I&E) regarding reports received on vehicles regularly parking by Island Medical Centre, as there is no unrestricted parking and this impacts patients trying to park. The Roads Committee (RC) agreed to request to I&E that the proposed yellow line from the junction of La Rue des Fonds is painted past La Prevalaye to where the road narrows on both sides. The RC recommended that a 12 in 24 hour parking restriction is made between the entrance of the Beausite Hotel to the corner of the road where it bends. ML said he will report this back to I&E.
5. Asbestos Removal	ML advised that two quotes have been received for the removal of asbestos in the basement at the Parish Hall. Following advice from the RC, they recommended that the Parish proceed with TFM Limited however, the final decision will be with the Procureurs du Bien Public and the Connétable.
6. La Rue des Alleurs Wall Project - Electrical Work	ML advised that two quotes have been received for the electrical work required at the Parish Hall before work is undertaken on the wall on La Rue des Alleurs. Following advice from the RC, they recommended the Parish proceed with Harben Electrical Services Ltd as the alternative quotation did not include several elements of the required scope of work. However, the final decision will be with the Procureurs du Bien Public and the Connétable.

8.1. La Rue de la Marais a la Cocque	Following reports of road subsidence on La Rue de la Marais a la Cocque, believed to be associated with the use of heavy vehicles by D B Cummins Ltd, DBC confirmed that their lorries arrive and depart from the premises empty. It was further noted that Woodlands Farms and Highbury Farm also use the road with heavy vehicles, and that tractors regularly travel along it. It was agreed that the cause could not be attributed to a single company. DBC also commented that the drainpipe recently repaired on the road was over 50 years old.
8.2. Branchage	HG gave her apologies for the Branchage taking place on Friday, 03 July 2026.
8.3. Potholes	The RC to arrange a site visit to Le Boulivot de Bas and La Rue au Blancq to investigate reports of several potholes.
